Special Aspects

BAEA (24) ages not noted. Editor's note: WVMF is noted for it's high wintering eagle numbers, along with other eastern West Virginia CBC circles.

This was the first year that the count had access to the Ashton Woods gated community lands. This property is largely upland coniferous and its coverage helped raise the numbers of species like WBNU, DEJU, GCKI, BCCH, TUTI, DOWO, BRCR, and other species in mixed winter flocks. Notably there was 2"-4" of snow over much of the count circle and this highlighted the presence of several irruption species, including record numbers of RBNU, EVGR, and the counts first PISI.

Editor's Note: The high count (17) NOHA is far above the average WVMF 3 bird average. Previous NOHA H/C, 10, reported on the 113th.
