Regional Editor's Note: This is the first official CBC for the WVPP count. A trial CBC was conducted during the 120th season with excellent results. WVPP is located in Mason County WV, near Point Pleasant WV.

Mason County did have two CBC circles in the past.

WVOM was created during the winter of 1953-1954, it ran for 10 inconsecutive years. WVOM began on the 54th CBC, then went dormant 9 years before restarting, it then conducted CBC's during the 63rd-71st seasons. The WVOM CBC was located around 7 miles south of Point Pleasant.

The other Mason County CBC existing during this time period was the WV0N CBC. It was centered just outside Point Pleasant in Henderson near the Kanawha River. WV0N ran for 8 inconsecutive years, 61st, 62nd, then again during the 72nd-77th seasons.

Looking at the years these two counts, WVOM and WVON, were conducted, I notice that both counts never ran simultaneously, and appear to have been connected in some way.

The new WVPP (Point Pleasant) CBC is centered around 1.5 miles east of Point Pleasant, closer to where the WV0N count was conducted.
