Special Aspects

GEHE (1) Found along the bank of Coal River at the Lock Four Park of the Alum Creek Lions Club, this was only the third WVCH CBC record, historically on a WV CBC the 12th record.

Due to intense rain and very poor visibility this year at dusk when the crows come to the big roost, the count of crows was significantly lower than in previous years. This was a result of very poor viewing conditions and not necessarily due to a smaller population. The count is an estimate based upon the number of groups of 25 individuals moving past one point for as long as the light allowed.
