Special Aspects

The Point Pleasant CBC was much more birder-friendly in 2021 on the 122nd count, with nice weather in the mid-50's through most of the day. Total participation was down slightly, as some were unable to join so close to Christmas, and a couple of other prior participants chased rare birds in Texas at the last minute. Because of this we had fewer groups to cover the same ground. Still, some nice birds were found, including a group of fourteen Brewer's Blackbirds, seven Greater White-fronted Geese, three American Woodcock, and a count week Snowy Owl. I was nearly finished when Mike Griffith sent me the message about the Brewer's Blackbirds, and thankfully was able to get on them for a good twenty minutes before they were chased off by a Peregrine Falcon. Seeing a life bird on my home count was a nice way to end the day.

We had some friends and family of Rennie Talbert join the count this year, which has been a goal of mine. I hope we can continue to bring more folks into birding with this count. This area doesn't have many birders, and next year if covid allows, I plan to reach out to the local community to get more participants to go with birders like Mike Griffith and Jason White who I consider experts.
