Mountain Nature Camp is located on an 18-acre peninsula of rural Terra Alta Lake in Preston County, West Virginia. Classes are on or near the grounds. Field trips, within 60 miles of camp, include some of the most scenic and diverse locations in the West Virginia mountains.



Facilities: The lodge has a knotty pine meeting room, dining room, and a professional kitchen. It is surrounded by woods with trails, meadows, and the lake. Our shower house has flush toilets and private showers.

Lodging: Sleep in your own tent in the woods or meadow. (Or make your own arrangements at nearby Alpine Lake Resort.)

Meals: Home-cooked meals using fresh/local produce. Day field trips include picnic lunch and sometimes dinner. Most special dietary needs can be accommodated.

Staff: Our naturalists and professional interpreters are distinguished for their knowledge and their ability to teach both beginners and experts in Botany, Ornithology, Ecology, Natural History and other topics.
