Committee Member Comments:

CM1: The photographs of the bird are sufficient for identification in my opinion. I would have preferred more of a written description and at least some mention of how wild provenance was decided upon, but to my knowledge no evidence of banding or cage wear was seen. This species is a known vagrant to this part of the country. The evidence therefore points to this being a legitimately wild bird. Thus I feel a vote FOR this record is justified in my opinion.

CM2: Photographs show without a doubt this species. The timing also fits with established seasonal vagrancy of this species. Good documentation.

CM3: Good description and pics.

CM4: Photographic evidence. Multiple observers.

CM5: Good quality photos, white wing patch at rest clearly visible, and a bit of the black edging also, and the blunt square tail. Black cheek patch also visible.

CM6: Well documented.

CM7: Accepted without comment.
