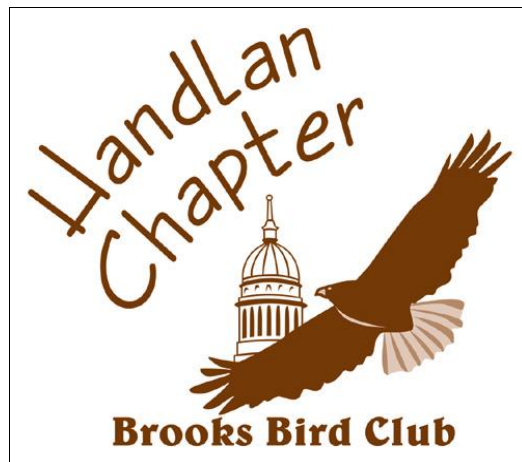


HANDLAN NEWSLETTER
