| which I also used to take photos by digiscoping. Given the time (11am), the sun was high above.   |
| The bird was shaded by bushes along the edge of the pond.   |

| I have observed brewer's blackbirds twice before. The first time was at Rattlesnake Springs in New  |
| Mexico, and the second time was also in Mason County, near a farm on Johns Kay Lane, Southside, WV.   |

| I have observed rusty blackbirds 9 times, including 3 times in WV during November. Male rusty   |
