

**Cerulean Warbler (*Setophaga cerulean*)**

**WINTER:** NO RECORDS.

**SUMMER:** Fairly Common Resident. Previously Common to Very Common Resident. See Remarks section.

**MIGRATION:**

**Spring:** Fairly Common Migrant from mid-April to early May. Early dates, 14 April 1945 (Edeburn et al. 1960); 15 April 2012 (JW); 17 April 2005 (PT); 18 April 2004 (MG); 19 April 2002 (GR), 2003 (WA, MG), 2006 (MG), 2008 (MG, DP); 2010 (AT, RT) and 2012 (MG); 20 April 2007 (JW).

**Fall:** Uncommon Migrant with most departing by late August. Late dates, 17 September 1955 (Edeburn et al. 1960); 13 September 2010 (WA); 06 September 2003 (WA, MG, DP); 01 September 1969 (HS) and 2003 (MG, DP).

Singing Male Census (Hall 1952): Cabwaylingo State Forest, Wayne Co., WV (1952): Tick Ridge: dominant canopy: 50% mixed oak (elevation, 335 m to 366 m): 16 males/100 ha.

Breeding Bird Survey (Bullard 2003): Cabwaylingo State Forest, Wayne Co., WV (2002): 135 Stops (7 surveys), 64 Mile. Number of Stops Recorded: 20. Total Birds: 23.

Singing Male Census (Koch and Hurley 1972): Beech Fork Lake, Wayne Co., WV (1969): mature mesophytic forest (elevation, 198 m to 244 m): 82 males/100 ha.

Breeding Bird Survey (Koch and Hurley 1972): Beech Fork Lake, Wayne Co., WV (29 May 1969): 50 Stops, 25 Mile. Number of Stops Recorded: 4. Total Birds: 4.

Singing Male Census (Koch 1974): McClintic WMA, Mason Co., WV (1971): hardwood forest (elevation, 250 m to 259 m): 99 males/100 ha.
