## Killdeer (Charadrius vociferous)

**WINTER:** Uncommon to Fairly Common Resident. Common to Very Common during mild winters. See Remarks section for CBC data.

**SUMMER:** Common to Very Common Resident. See Remarks section.

## **MIGRATION:**

Spring: Fairly Common to Common Migrant from late February through March (Slack 1978).

**Fall:** Common to Very Common Migrant from September to November, with peak numbers occurring from October into November (Slack 1978). See Remarks section for high counts.
