The 124th CBC in Moorefield went quite well. High winds throughout the day kept birds hunkered down, especially at high altitude. The count was pleased to include a new local participant this year in Mr. Nate Irwin as well as the return of former compilers Kathy King and Jane Whitaker to run a feeder count!

Nearly all water was open, but there were only average or below average numbers of waterfall and wading birds, including no great blue herons for the first time on the count.

A good crop of cedar berries likely contributed to record numbers of Cedar Waxwings, Yellow-rumped warblers and Fox Sparrows. Additionally, Fred Atwood located a large flock of American Pipits along Huttar Rd, contributing to an all-time count of that species.
